Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)

A national volunteer program assisting families at tax time since the early 1970s. The program is authorized by the Department of Treasury and administered by the Internal Revenue Service (IRS).

Why: Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit



- EITC and CTC are tax credits designed to promote work and to lift families out of poverty. These credits are only available to people who file federal tax returns.
- EITC and CTC together lifted **10.6 million** people above the poverty line and made poverty less severe for 17.5 million others in 2018.
- The IRS estimates that 20% of eligible families do not claim EITC, either because they do not know they can, or they do not file a tax return.


Our Region





TRAINING:

December & January dates for virtual training

- Tech training video, Part A, & Part B
- Will be recorded & posted online

TAX SEASON:

End of January 2025 – April 15, 2025

COMMITMENT:

Three shifts per season. Each shift is 4-6 hours on a weeknight or Saturday (some weekdays available).

Quality & Certification

IRS CERTIFICATION

- Certification is a series of annual, online IRS tests
- CEs for CPAs, CFAs, & other tax preparers
- Certified volunteers are protected from liability

ASSURING QUALITY

- Strict code of ethics
- New volunteers shadow experienced volunteers
- Multiple volunteers review each return
- Experienced coordinator onsite



Volunteer Protection Act
Public Law 105-19, Volunteer
Protection Act of 1997 (VPA)
Protects volunteers from liability for acts they perform within the scope of their responsibilities as a volunteer.

FTP Site Framework



In-Person Service

Traditional Face-to-Face Service



Drop-Off In-person

Taxpayers completing paperwork separate from volunteers; returns prepared primarily on site with taxpayers waiting in separate space

Drop-OffVirtual-Hybrid

Administered with volunteers scanning taxpayers' documents; volunteers preparing offsite and taxpayers returning later to retrieve paperwork
